

FOHF News - summer term events!

We have some exciting fundraising events coming up this term for the children to take part in ... but firstly, a huge thank you to our Easter bunnies who helped hide eggs last term, the children had a great time hunting!



School discos - £2 per child plus tuck money

Key Stage 1 (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) - Friday 10th May 3-4.30pm

Key Stage 2 (Years 3 to 6) - Friday 17th May 3.30-5pm

If children are attending the discos they need to bring their party clothes to school in a named bag so they can get changed. Children should be collected from their classrooms at 4.30pm (KS1) & 5pm (KS2) - they will not be allowed to walk home at 5pm as it is much later than normal.

Tuck: there will be hot-dogs (£1), sweets (mixed bags of 50p & Freddos/Fudges at 25p for the infants, individual items from 10p upwards for the juniors), crisps (30p) and drinks (30p) on sale at both discos, children should bring their tuck money into school in a named purse, bag or wallet please - not just in their pocket! **We will ensure there are allergy friendly options too**

We need parent helpers to run the discos and to bag sweets beforehand - remember many hands really do make light work and all help is very much appreciated.

Sports Day - Wednesday 5th June

Infants 9.30am to 11.30am. Juniors 1pm to 3pm. We will be running our usual refreshments stall at sports day selling tea, coffee, cold drinks and biscuits.

Volunteers are needed throughout the day to help run the stall.



Summer Fair - Wednesday 26th June 3-5pm

We'd like to hear your thoughts on what you enjoyed most last year and if there's anything else you'd like before we pull together a list of stalls this year.
