Sefton schools - #kNOwKnifeCrime Initiative

Dear Parent / Carer,

Your child has been selected to participate in the school-to-school relay event on Wednesday 17th April to spread our message of #kNOwknifecrime.

On Wednesday 17th April, runners from Holy Family will run to Bishop David Sheppard. We will start our run at **9:10am** so children will need to be at school ready for **8:30am**. We will run from Norwood Crescent, down Hereford Road onto Heysham Road and across Old Park Lane to Devonshire Road. We will then cross Lawson Street and into the School grounds of Bishop David Sheppard. We will then make our way back to Holy Family by walking back along the same route – hopefully without any rainfall! The Southport schools run will end with runners from Christ the King High school arriving back at Kew Woods for around 3:20pm. We would love to see your support on the Crescent!

We will be raising money for the purchase of bleeding control kits and cabinet for outside our school. A bleeding control kit can help provide support for the bleeding caused by knife injuries to make the difference for a victim to survive an attack. The kits were developed by the Major Trauma Centre at Aintree University Hospital. The aim of the fundraising is to ensure that there are bleeding control kits in as many locations as possible throughout the Borough. 84 schools in Sefton are participating in this event.
