Dear Parents/Carers,

On Thursday 19th October, Year 6 will be visiting Lancashire Museum to support their topic on WW1. They will be taking part in a fully immersive and hands-on session where they will take a journey to the trenches of France. Here they will join WWI sergeants as they prepare them for war. Pupils will experience life and conditions in the trenches, daily duties and drill, find out about trench slang, food, equipment and be part of a working party. Pupils will then be put through their paces as they are formed up and taken through parade and rifle drill. This is a truly unique and inspiring session taking place within a life-size 60 foot WWI trench.

Trip details

- **Thursday 19th October 2023** – the trip takes places during the school day
please arrive at school at **8.45am** so we can register the children and walk round to Grange Road in order to leave at 9am prompt
- **Cost: £17.25** per child – to be paid by Monday 16th October
- **Clothes:** Children need to wear school uniform
- **Food:** Children need to bring a packed lunch in a disposable bag, no cans or bottles please - if your child normally has a school dinner and you need us to provide a packed lunch please let the office know by the end of next week (13th October)

Please bear in mind that although contributions are voluntary, the cost of the trip is divided equally between the number of children going. If not enough contributions are received, unfortunately the trip will have to be cancelled. Please speak to your child's class teacher or Mrs Watkins in the office if there is a problem with making your contribution.
