Southport Foodbank support more and more families across the local area. They urgently need savoury crackers, pasta sauce, tinned meat e.g. corned beef or ham, tinned fruit, tinned tomatoes, instant noodles, tomato sauce, brown sauce, mayo, long-life juice and cordial, UHT milk, 'free from' items and jam. CAFOD's harvest appeal this year is focussing on the families impacted by the flooding in Pakistan and the mobile clinics that provide medical help. Family Fast day is Friday 6th October, more details and how to make a donation can be found on their website. £10 can help fund 4 emergency doctor's appointment, £40 can provide food and medical care to vulnerable mums and their newborn babies, £125 can get a mobile clinic to communities that don't have a hospital nearby.
