

School Uniform

Uniform is worn at Holy Family Catholic Primary to develop a sense of pride in being a member of the school community.

Girls

Autumn/Spring uniform:

- Dark green skirt of pinafore or dark grey trousers
- Dark green cardigan or jumper with or without logo
- White shirt
- School tie
- Black shoes – no high heels, no trainers

Summer uniform:

- Green and white checked or striped dress
- Yellow polo shirt (with or without school logo) with dark green skirt or dark grey trousers/knee length shorts.
- Dark green cardigan with or without logo
- Black shoes – no high heels, no trainers

Boys

Autumn/Spring uniform:

- Dark grey, long or short trousers
- Dark green jumper with or without logo
- White shirt
- School tie
- Black shoes – no trainers

Summer uniform:

- Dark grey shorts or trousers
- Yellow polo shirt with or without school logo
- Dark green jumper with or without logo
- Black shoes – no trainers

PE Kit

- White T-shirt with or without logo
- Black shorts
- Trainers / black pumps (for games)
- Plain black or Navy tracksuits may be worn over PE kits for outdoor games lessons but they should have large no names or logos.

Extras - All Reception children should have a named pair of Wellington boots for outdoor play.

Uniform with logos can be bought at

Non-branded uniform can be bought at all major supermarkets & department stores.

Jewellery

For many reasons, including safety, we do not allow children to wear jewellery.

The exceptions to this rule are:

- Ear ring studs in pierced ears.
- Analogue or digital watches.

Please note, smart watches with various apps are not to be worn to school though.

However, children will be required to remove or cover up any items for P.E. lessons to prevent them from causing injury.

Hair & Make Up

- Hair below the shoulder is to be tied up. If a child comes into school with it down, they will be asked to tie it up.
- Hair bands, ribbons/bows or 'scrunchies' should be plain and either dark green, yellow or black to match our uniform.
- Hair bands should not have large flowers or other decoration attached.
- Make up and nail varnish should not be worn to school.
- Extreme hairstyles are not appropriate for school. The use of styling products should be kept to a minimum and children should not have decorative patterns such as tramlines cut into their hair or have hair coloured or dyed.
