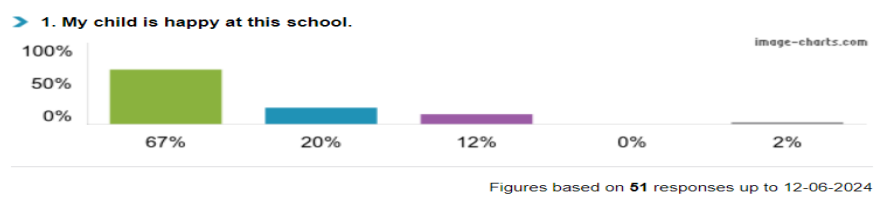

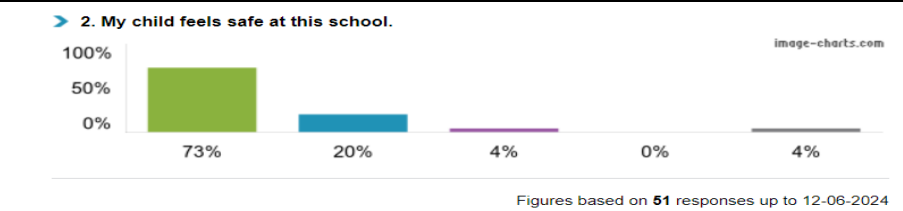

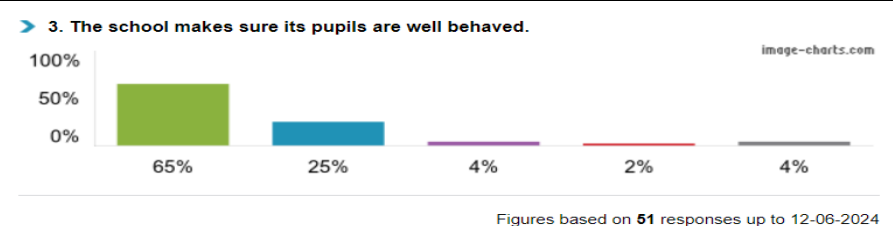
87% of our children are happy at school.



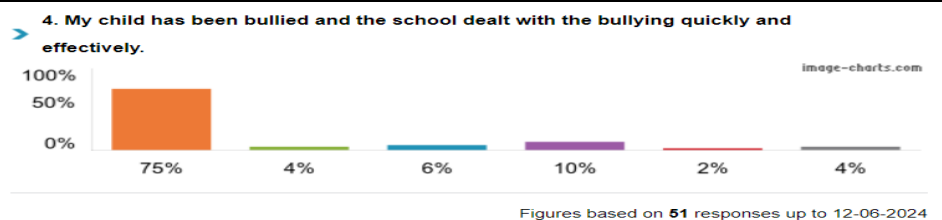
93% of our children feel safe at this school.



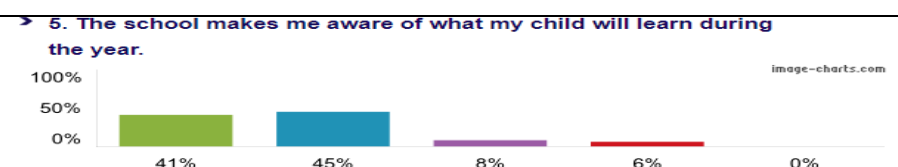
90% of parents, feel that behaviour is instilled and children are well-behaved.

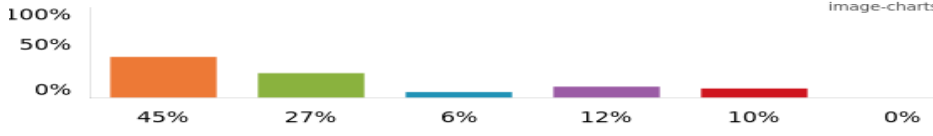
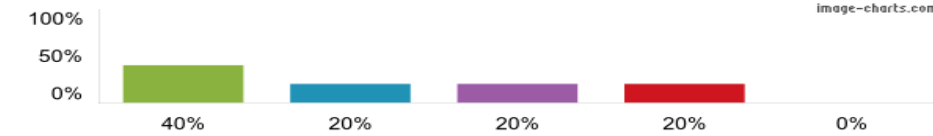
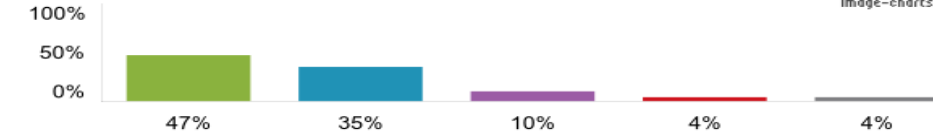
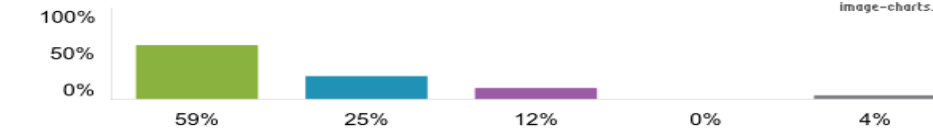
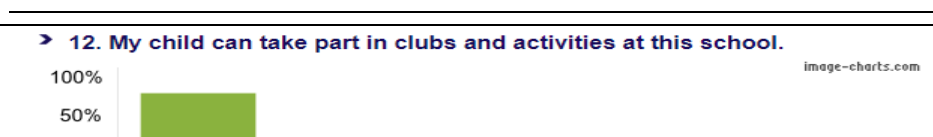


79% of parents, feel that our school deals bullying quickly and effectively
