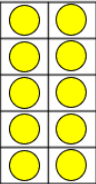
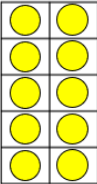
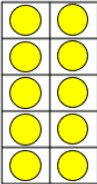

We are continuing to learn about partitioning numbers in to tens and ones and now extending that to think of other ways we can make numbers. For example:

			
35 can be partitioned into <u>30</u> and <u>5</u>			
35 can be partitioned into <u>20</u> and <u>15</u>			
35 can be partitioned into <u>10</u> and <u>25</u>			

We have used maths equipment to help us partition numbers in this way and we have spotted patterns. To support your child with this, practise counting in 10s. (For example: 10, 20, 30, 40 ... and 15, 25, 35, 45, 55 ...)
