We have now completed all of this half term's weekly spellings. Our next spelling test will be on **14th December** and will be the Year 1 common exception words. On **15th December**, we will test the Year 2 common exception words.

Over the next week and a half take some time to practise these common exception words. You should already have a copy of them but please ask if you have misplaced the sheet. In the same way you did last half term, choose a few words at a time to practise, focusing on words your child is unsure of.

Remember, we do not expect that your child can read and write them all yet. Year 2 words are a target to be achieve by the END of Year 2.

Start practising Year 1 common exception words and only move on to Year 2 common exception words if your child is secure with Year 1.

For children who are confident reading and spelling all Year 1 and 2 words, you should already have a list of Year 3 and 4 words to work on, if you wish to.

Maths

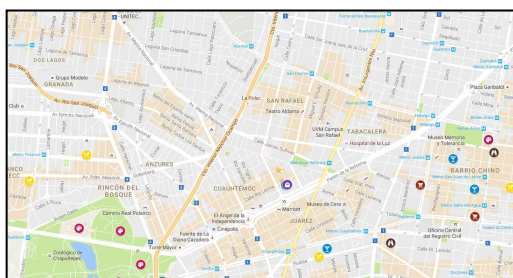
Have a go at the following game to review everything we have learned about 2D shapes:
