Remember: Leave in term time can not be authorised unless exceptional circumstances. Each case will be reviewed on an individual basis.

Uniform Reminder for September:

Girls; dark green skirt or pinafore or dark grey trousers, dark green cardigan or jumper with or without school logo, white shirt with school tie, white socks or green tights, black shoes (no heels), long hair should be tied back with green, yellow, black or white bobbles/ribbons. No large bows.

Boys; dark grey long or short trousers, dark green jumper with or without school logo, white shirt with school tie, grey socks, black shoes. No tram lines in hair, long hair must be tied back.

PE Kit; black shorts, white t-shirt with or without school logo, trainers or black pumps. Children can also wear a plain black or navy tracksuit. Children should come to school in their PE kit on PE days.

IMPORTANT: children are **not** allowed to wear football kits or any items of clothing with a logo on (unless it is the Holy Family crest). If your child comes to school in the wrong PE kit we will make a phone call home. If for any reason you are unable to bring the correct kit into school they will be given a spare set to wear for the day.
