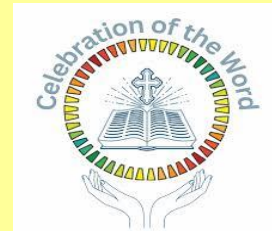
Well done to our Y6....
