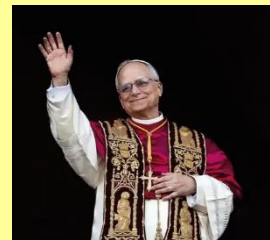


A book of condolence is still open for people across our archdiocese to pay respects to Pope Francis.
