Unfortunately, KS2 children have been spoken to several times about the behaviour in the KS2 toilets. In the Y5 toilets, toilet rolls have been found thrown in the toilet and 'mess' on the floor with the toilets being purposely missed. Over Easter, we had new toilets installed in the Y3/Y4 area, they have been vandalised. Scratches have been found on the side of the cubicle. This is totally unacceptable. As a result, children are now only allowed in one at a time with adults going in to check them when they have been in. It is awful that we have to resort to these measures but we feel that this at the moment this is the only way to control it, as someone/ some children are continuing to abuse the toilets. Please can you speak with your child also.
