The classes with the best punctuality this week are Y2, Y5 & Y6 – well done!



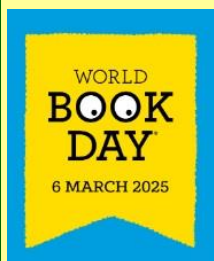
