Following the cancellation of our Summer BBQ, we are pleased to announce that we will be

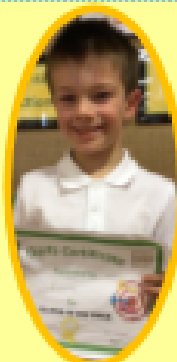

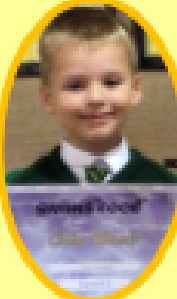

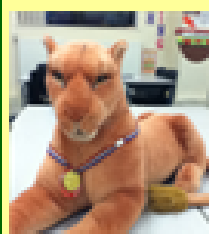
